SPARKLING

Bin no. 17 Kits Coty Blanc de Blanc, Kent £70.00

This wine shows typical aromas of cool climate Blanc de Blancs; green apple and freshly baked bread. The palate is showing development from maturation on lees and a toasty character from partial barrel fermentation. A savoury finish with fine, persistent bubbles.

Bin no. 25 Perrier Jouet, France (Half Bottle) £36.00

Perrier Jouet has an attractive bouquet with youthful delicate floral hints. Elegance, finesse and extraordinary craftsmanship are all associated with this champagne house. Lively persistent bubbles in the mouth with soft and creamy fruit flavours. Elegant and a beautifully balanced champagne

Bin no. 28 Woodchurch Rose, Kent £45.00

Rose gold in colour with floral and red berry aromas, the wine is full of fruit flavours including strawberry, peach, and melon combined with tangy citrus notes.

Bin no. 67 Irroy Extra Brut Champagne, France .. £45.00

Slightly developed, intense yellowish-pale green color. Surprisingly developed nose with rich and nuanced aromas of toasted bread, peanut butter; some smoky character; a little bit of creaminess, hints of apple-driven white fruit and a sweet touch of lemon marmalade

REDS

Bin no. 32 Château Batailley,

Pauillac Grand Cru Classé 2013, France £125.00

The 2013 Batailley has a relatively backward bouquet, however, there is respectable fruit concentration here for the vintage: blackberry, cedar and cigar box, your typical traits for this estate. The palate offers commendable weight and extraction: not a Batailley of finesse or even complexity, though one with a modicum of presence and substance. Given this is a 2013 there is negligible under-ripeness on the tensile and almost steely finish.

Bin no. 16

Chateau Musar 2003, Lebanon £85.00

Think Bordeaux meets Arabian Nights, Chateau Musar's indulgent, sensuous flavours make it an unforgettable experience. It is also a testament to winemaking passion, dedication and bravery in the face of a 15-year civil war.

Bin no. 50

Castello Banfi Brunello De Montalcino, Italy £60.00

Elegant and balanced Brunello, characterized by a sweet, rich and complex aroma of fruit jam. A wine with great structure that is well balanced by a good softness and acidity on the final. Extremely persistent with excellent aging potential.

Bin no. 51

Chapel Down Pinot Noir 2015, Kent £35.00

herbal, spicy notes with sour cherry, light tannins + nicely balanced. elegant, fine tannins, moderate acidity, impressive wine

Bin no. 76

Simpsons Rabbit Hole Pinot Noir 2018 £35.00

Deep, vibrant crimson colour, with aromas of redcurrants, blueberries, exotic spices and fresh coffee. Bursting with black fruits in the mouth; beautifully silky, ripe and weighty.

Bin no. 36

Biddenden Gamay Noir 2015, Kent £30.00

Light-bodied, easy-drinking gamay noir is similar in style to pinot noir; with its cherry and plum flavours and light floral notes

WHITE

Bin no. 54

Simpsons Derringstone Pinot Meunier 2018 £35.00

Aromas of balsamic-poached winter fruit and citrus-peel, Succulent and creamy-textured, with a crisply-mineral finish. Derringstone is England's first still white wine made from Pinot Meunier:

Bin no. 23

Chapel Down Chardonnay 2015, Kent £35.00

An elegant unoaked Chardonnay with aromas of green apple, white peach and kiwi fruit. The palate is light, fresh and aromatic with a smooth texture and background notes of butter leading to a crisp finish.

Bin no. 40

Simpsons Gravel Stone Chardonnay 2015, Kent . £30.00

Pale gold in colour, with aromas of citrus, ripe apple and nashi pear. A note of tropical fruit in the mouth is balanced by crisp minerals.

Bin no. 87

Trimbach Pinot Blanc 2017, France £32.00

The nose is reminiscent of champagne, with baked apples, lemons and hints of yeast lees.

Bin no. 51

Picpoul de Pinet Réserve, France 2018 £28.00

Crisp, light and aromatic, with remarkable freshness on the palate. This Languedoc classic is wonderful with summer dining or on its own on a hot day.

Bin no. 53

Gusbourne Guinevere 2107 £59.00

100% hand-harvested Chardonnay from the Boot Hill vineyard. This is only made in very small quantities from the best vintages. Therefore there is no immediate follow on vintage. Cool climate, Chablisienne style with delicately perfumed citrus fruit, underlying light vanilla touches and a creamy, textural richness. Slightly spicy aromas of green apple and subtle oak notes, racy acidity, and good vigour and drive.
